



Peer Review Process

Guidelines for giving and receiving feedback
about your preliminary badge designs

Based on the Tuning Protocol

We've matched you with organizations for peer review – we've tried to match you based on alignment of programming, but even if you're with another organization quite different from your own, that's okay. There's still great value in receiving feedback from organizations who work with youth.

Steps in the Process

Be mindful of time. You are encouraged to continue these conversations after today's session.

- Educator shares the overall goals and high level description of summer programming to which the badge applies (1 min)
- Educator presents Badge Design Template Steps 1 & 2 (4 min)
- Peers ask educator clarifying questions only, educator responds (3 min)
- Peers give warm and cool feedback to educator and identify possible solutions. Educator is silent during this section. (5 min)
- Educator shares their reflections on the feedback by stating what they've heard and thinking aloud about possible solutions (2 min)

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
